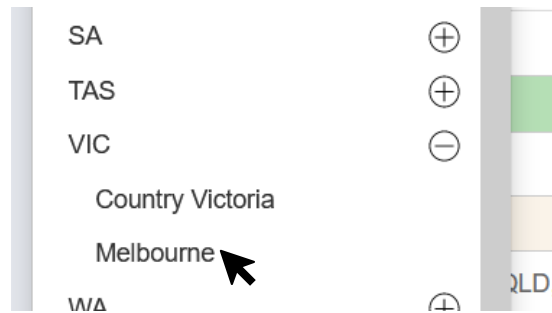
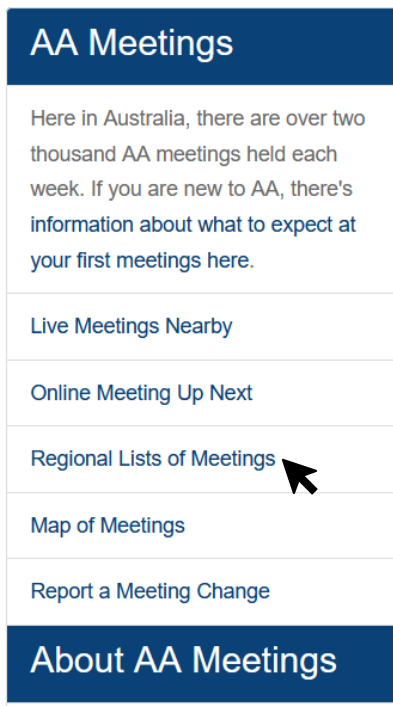


## How to update your Meeting listing or create a new Meeting

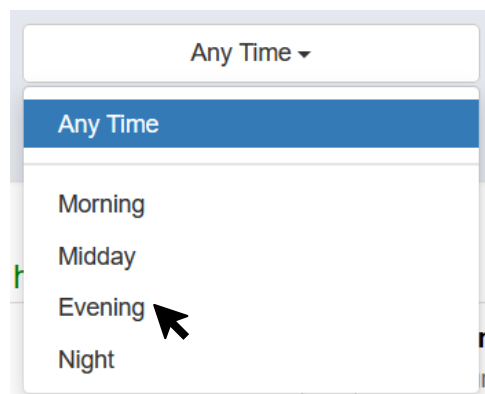
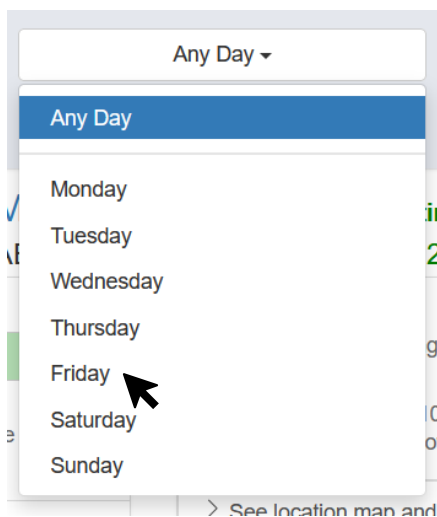
### 1 Update your existing live or online meeting
